### **Two types of membership available!**

#### **1. Tournament Players Card**

Your Green, Bronze, Silver, or Gold card allows you to play in our tournaments. NCGA membership included. **Completion of the REPS course is required.**

To receive a **Tournament Players Card**:

- Fill out a membership form, pay the \$50 annual fee by credit card, and sign-up for a REPS Course online at [www.SCCJGA.com](http://www.SCCJGA.com)
- Parent or guardian and junior golfer must agree to the Code of Conduct
- Complete the REPS course
- Receive your membership card immediately upon completing the course!

All **Tournament Players Card** members are required to complete the R.E.P.S. (Rules, Etiquette, Pace and Safety) course once each year. The course is key to ensuring all juniors are playing safely, keeping up pace of play and following the USGA Rules.

#### **2. Blue Membership Card**

For those new to golf or those not yet ready to play in tournaments, but still wish to receive all other membership benefits including: discounted green fees and range balls, lessons and free clinics, the Blue card may be right for you. NCGA membership is *not* included and, although the REPS course is recommended, it is *not* required.

To receive a **Blue Membership Card**:

- Fill out a registration form and pay the \$50 annual fee by credit card online at [www.SCCJGA.com](http://www.SCCJGA.com)
- Parent or guardian and junior golfer must agree to the Code of Conduct
- Receive your membership card by mail

## Lessons

SCCJGA has a limited number of scholarships available to subsidize the fee for Level 1 thru 4 lessons offered by Functional Junior Golf at DeLaveaga. The scholarships pay for 50% of the fee for a four-day course, and are available on a first come, first served, basis. ## Advancement Skills Test

Test your skills in driving, pitching, chipping, and putting to advance to the next card level. Testing is now offered by appointment only. ## Advancement Scores

You no longer need to win tournaments to advance. Now you can advance to the next card level by scoring low in three (3) SCCJGA tournaments. Also, if you do not meet the target scores three times this year, tournament scores are carried forward to the following year.

Shoot these target scores in three (3) SCCJGA tournaments to advance to the next card level:

#### Boys

Green to Bronze: 42 or lower  
Bronze to Silver: 17 over par or lower  
Silver to Gold: 7 over par or lower

#### Girls

Green to Bronze: 48 or lower  
Bronze to Silver: 27 over par or lower  
Silver to Gold: 17 over par or lower
